## CHECK LIST & DUTIES FOR CLUB MARSHALLS & OFFICIALS

Club marshalls and officials are an essential part of conducting a safe road cycle race.

It is the responsibility of the Coastal Senior Cycling Club Inc. to ensure the club marshalls and officials are properly briefed for their task and particular location prior to the commencement of a road cycle race.

The duties of club marshalls and officials include providing direction to competing riders as well as minor traffic control.

Club marshalls and officials or any other club member associated with a cycle race conducted by the Coastal Senior Cycling Club Inc. have no legal authority to direct traffic and they cannot stop, hold or direct traffic on any public road.

Club marshalls and officials need certain information in order to do their tasks effectively during a road cycle race conducted by the Coastal Senior Cycling Club Inc. and are required to know:

- Their dress and equipment requirements. Club marshalls and officials are required to wear high visibility reflective vests and display a red flag warning motorists approaching their marshalling position.
- The entire race course, starting times and estimated finishing times of the road cycle race in order to answer motorists questions.
- The time and direction to expect competing riders moving through their marshalling position.

If you are involved with the Coastal Senior Cycling Club Inc. in the role of a marshall or race official please ensure you familiarise yourself and have an understanding of the listed requirements.
