RACE MANAGER

- 1. Check that signs have been placed in correct position prior to the race start. (See person rostered for sign duties).
- 2. Check that lead and tail car have front and rear warning signs and orange flashing lights on their vehicles prior to race start.
- 3. <u>ENSURE FIRST AID KITS & 2-WAY RADIOS ARE WITH LEAD AND TAIL CAR.</u> (See persons rostered for lead and tail escort car duties).
- **4.** Check that any race marshall wears a high visibility vest and has a red flag to warn motorists approaching their marshalling position.
- **5.** Conduct briefing prior to race start outlining the following:
 - Mention race sponsor
 - Read out handicap marks or grades.
 - Type of race to be held (handicap, mass start, etc.)
 - The race course and where the start/finish line will be.
 - Any known hazards on the race course.
 - Inform all riders that it is their <u>individual</u> responsibility to obey all road rules during the race and ride in a safe and responsible manner.
- 6. RIDERS ARE TO NEVER CROSS THE CENTRE LINE OF THE ROAD DURING A RACE. (Sanctions for crossing a centre line range from warning for accidental crossing, relegation or disqualification in the cycle race.)
- 7. ALL RIDERS MUST HAVE A WORKING TAIL LIGHT.
- **8.** Where the after race presentations are to be held.

AFTER RACE PRESENTATIONS

- 1. Read out race results and present race prizes.
- **2.** Thank the race sponsor.
- 3. Inform riders where the next race will be held.
