

TAIL CAR – DRIVER CHECKLIST

- Have you confirmed your role as the “Tail Vehicle Driver”
- Are you familiar with the course and number of laps?
- Do you have a safety vest and a yellow flashing roof light – Does it work?
- Do you have a First Aid Kit in case of an emergency or crash?
- Is the sign “Caution Cyclists Ahead” fitted to the rear of your vehicle?
- Are you able to communicate with finish line officials or the Commissaire?
- You must obey the Road Rules at all times.
- You should be between 50 – 100m in behind the last rider.
- In case of an accident ensure riders have First Aid attention before continuing.
- If carrying spare wheels, always ensure it is safe to pull over to the left hand side of the road before attending to riders.
- No assistance should be provided to riders that involves drafting behind your vehicle or riders hanging onto your vehicle.
